This day came in with the wind N.W. lite all sail set steering S by E by 1/2 E rigged the cutting stage and doing other odd jobs so wide - No 6 be

Sunday Sep 30th

This day came in with moderate breeze from S.W. steering to the S.W. employed in different work about deck

Monday Oct 1st

This day came in with fresh breeze from N. steering S by E under all sail broke out water vinegar employed in getting the whaling gear ready so wide

Tuesday Oct 2^d

This day came in with moderate weather midnight wind hauled S. latched ship to the N.W. at 1 P.M. fresh breeze from S. under easy sail employed in ships duty passed some drift stuff

Wednesday Oct 3^d

This day came in with a fresh gale from S. and rainy at 5 am took in flying jib. Tallyant, mainmast, stowal furled the mainmast carried away foreals main stowal broke out and bent new ones bent main trysal 5.30 P.M. wind hauled N steering to S by E under lower topsal fore stowal main trysal 7 P.M. blowing fresh from N.

Thursday Oct 4th

This day came in with a gale and heavy sea on at 7 P.M. main stowal carried away on account of the eye bolt hauling out of the deck took and unbent it - dried it and began repairing it - Rone off new fore brace and fore buntline at 12 or noon moderated made all sail below tallyant sail 7 P.M. moderate breeze from N. steering to S. by E

Friday Oct 5th

This day came with lite air and calm repaired main stowal and doing other odd jobs at 9.30 saw and put letter aboard of a steamer bound to the S. sundown moderate breeze from S by E Brig headwind N.W. to under easy sail

Saturday Oct 6th

This day came in with fresh breeze from S. ship heading to S by E under easy sail employed in doing ships duty and ripping up the old foresal so wide No 6 be

Sunday Oct 7th

This day came in with a fresh Breeze from S. Brig heading to by S under easy sail at 4 P.M. moderated some set mainmast & jib

Monday Oct 8th

This day came in with a gale from S. at 1 P.M. wind moderate made sail and steered S by E under easy sail not much doing so wide
