

Sept. Frid 9, 1921

Frid This day begins with light rain squalls
wind gradually changing into ~~W~~
killed the west end moderating at 4:30
a light wind haled around to the North
day
yoke with all the lower sails set
Lat 35 53 N Long 67 28 W

Sat 10

To day begins with the wind from
the West yoke by the wind on
the starboard tack the watch busy
running the oil out of the tanks
into Casks. latter part see a steamer
wind freshened so reefed the main sail
Lat 36 40 N Long 69 08 West

Sunday 11. This day begins with moderate
Easterly winds yoke steering N by West
see steamer. latter part set all the light
sails Lat 36 24 N Long 69 43 West

Monday 12. To day the wind has been very light
from the East yoke with all sail set
steering North by East the mate busy
washing ship. latter part about calm
Lat 39 44 N Long 70 36 West
also unrigged the cutting top

Tues 13 Sept 1921

This day begins with very light weather at daylight
this morning main sail after having everything
~~was~~ furled in a calm all night middle part
the day the wind freshened from the
West yoke with all sail set steering
yoke by East at 5:30 PM raised the 13th
of 13 man land 2 top points of the lee boom
at 6:30 PM gybe head light in sight
got the chains up and bent them down
Lat at 2:30 PM 40 42 N Long 70 53 W
