 in day in a span like for the Starboard
 boat did not do duty in general have seen nothing
 worth note at anch Lat 29° 24' N
 Long 58° 57' W

Sunday 10th

To day fine
 steering by the wind all sail set heading S by W
 wind from S.E. employed in boat
 through the night steering by the wind heading
 (South by West) S.W. in the
 morning set the jib topsail doing night
 duty did not
 Lat 28° 25' N
 Long 59° 12' West

Monday 11th

This twenty
 four hours commencing with strong
 breeze from South East steering by
 the wind close ship's side At 10 AM
 pulled the jib jib heading through the night
 S by W at 1 PM light set the jib jib altered
 by the wind employed in setting up the
 Main rigging & gear forward do not
 do duty
 Lat 27° 30' N
 Long 59° 21' W
