47. Thick fog and rain with baffling winds the first part of this day. Middle part fresh Gale with Rain and Snow in squalls. Latter part light baffling breeze and pleasant saw several vessels at 10 A.M. spoke Schooner Emily Williard of Provincetown from Virginia for Boston. End pleasant and cold
Lat by Obs 40. 22 N.
Long by Obs 72. 12 W.

Wednesday April 12th/54
48. Begins with light breeze from the N. N. E heading to the Eastward 3 P.M. wore ship to the N. W. at 5 P.M. light breeze from S. E. Steering N. E. by N. 17. Strange Sails in sight
