

Bark Alford Bound out

Monday Sept. 27-1850
Started from
The dock at 8 with all hands
on board the Brig took us
to the Light Ship we
came to anchor at 12, a.m.

Tuesday Sept. 28
This day thick
fog ship to anchor off the
Light Ship mist to latter
part about the same wind
from the South by E. as usual
this day

Wednesday Sept. 29
This day thin
thick fog ship still to an-
chor at four a.m. light
ed. up some wind breezing
in from the S. by E. at six
let go the anchor and
part at 11 o'clock took our
anchors and stood out to
sea latter part employed
getting the anchors on the board
and rigging the boats

Thursday Sept 30
This day
Clear fine weather light breeze
steering a course of S. by E
found a man stowed
on board mid part light
breeze from the N. by E.
latter part fine weather
steering S. by E. by compass
to land this day
