This day calm
fine weather ship steering S by E

board, and part calm latter part

Thursday Oct 7

This day calm
fine weather light breeze from
the West ship steering to
the East nothing in sight
mid part fine hail from the
West of Stern N.E. & E. & calm
latter part steering S by E
bawling winds and hail
sent down some top sail hawl and
sent it up to the main nothing
in sight, so ends this day

Friday Oct 8

This day calm
generally hail from the N. East
Ship to the wind on the East
back mid & latter part
wind hauled more to the
East at ship on the S back
going to get to the E of the
Isle of Bonaire nothing in
sight

for Repair

Saturday Oct 9

This day calm
strong breeze ship on the S
back going to get East camp
doing necessary ship work on
board mid and latter part
about the same camp still
water nothing in sight

Sunday Oct 10

This day calm
strong breeze and squalls ship
on the N back with all
Pendant set, mid part
about the same latter part blowing
by moderate Gale from the East
Ship two on the N back
under double reef main top sail
and fore sail,

Monday Oct 11

This day calm
blowing a Gale from the East
Ship two under close
reef main top sail mid
part blowing heavy with rain
squalls latter part blowing a
moderate Gale and clear weather
Ship two under close reef
main top sail nothing in
sight so ends this day
