

Tuesday Oct. 12 This day commencing a moderate Gale from the Northth Ship Afore was on the Starboard tack under Close Reef main top sail, mid Part about the same latter Part at ten o'clock kept off for home we found that we could not get into Barmuda one sail in sight (Lat 37-28 N Long 64-47 W)

Wednesday Oct. 13 This day commencing a strong Eastly wind Ship steering N 50 E by N half S with all sail set one sail in sight mid Part about the same latter Part wind from the Northth Ship to the wind heading to the N 50 West all Present sail set one sail in sight (Lat 38-00 N Long 67-35 W)

Thursday Oct. 14 This day commencing a moderate Gale from the Northth Ship Afore was on the Starboard tack under Close Reef main top sail nothing in sight mid Part about the same latter Part more moderate made all Present sail Ship heading to the N 50 four sails in sight (Lat 35-55 N Long 68-34 W)

Friday Oct. 15 This day commencing fine weather strong breeze from the N 50 Ship by the wind on the Starboard tack one sail in sight mid Part latter Part fine weather light breeze from the Northth Ship by the wind on the Starboard tack two sails in sight (Lat 36-00 N Long 69-27 W)

Saturday Oct. 16 This day commencing fine weather light S.W. winds Ship by the wind heading to the North nothing in sight mid Part about the same latter Part moderate breeze Ship by the wind on the Port tack employed making a fore top sail yard three sails in sight (Lat 37-16 N Long 69-40 W)

Sunday Oct. 17 This day commencing fine weather moderate winds from the Westth finished the yard and sent it up and bent the sail three sails in sight mid Part strong breeze Ship steering N 50 E by N compass latter Part fine weather strong breeze from the N 50 Ship steering N 50 E one sail in sight (Lat 40-00 N Long 70-24 W)
