Saturday Sept 1st 1855

Clear weather strong breeze from N.E. employed in setting up rigging middle and latter part strong breeze from N.E. heading S.E. one ship in sight steering at W

Sunday Sept 2nd 1855

this day begins with strong breeze from N.E. equally middle and latter part wind from N.E. heading S.E. two ships in sight Lat 35° 56'

Monday Sept 3rd 1855

this begins with fine weather light air from E heading N.E. middle and latter part light breeze from S.W. at 8 and board fox sperm whale in company with the Bark Montgomery of New Bedford Lat 36° 50' N

Long 53° 31' W

Tuesday Sept 4th 1855

Clear weather wind from S.W. heading S.E. by S employed in chasing a whale in company with the Bark Montgomery middle part strong breeze from W.S.W. latter the same

Lat 35° 55' N

Wednesday Sept 5th 1855

pleasant weather light air from W.S.W. this gamey with the Bark Montgomery middle and latter part fine weather wind W.S.W. by S employed in ship study Lat 36° 58' N

Long 53° 10' W

Thursday Sept 6th 1855

fine weather wind from W.S.W. hours E & S

Bark E. Corning Rotech

Sunday September 9th 1855

this day begins with strong breeze from S.S.W. hours E at 9 and a breach ab three ships exchanged journals with one of them

Lat 39° 28' N
Long 44° 13' W

Monday Sept 9th 1855

this day begins with fine breeze from S.S.W. hours E by S at sail out

Tuesday Sept 13 1855

this begins with strong breeze from S.S.W. hours S by S heavy sea running at 7 pm saw a sperm whale but it was after sun set

Lat 40° 10' N
Long 36° 48' W

Friday Sept 14 1855

this begins with light air from N.W. hours S.E. by S at 9 pm board fox black fish got three one to each boat

Wednesday September 19th 1855

this day begins with strong breeze from W. laying off and on at the Island of flowers for recruits

Friday September 21st 1855

this day begins with fine weather a light air from W heading by winds with starboard to and board at 4 pm board fox whaler struck to W boat at 6 pm took him along side
