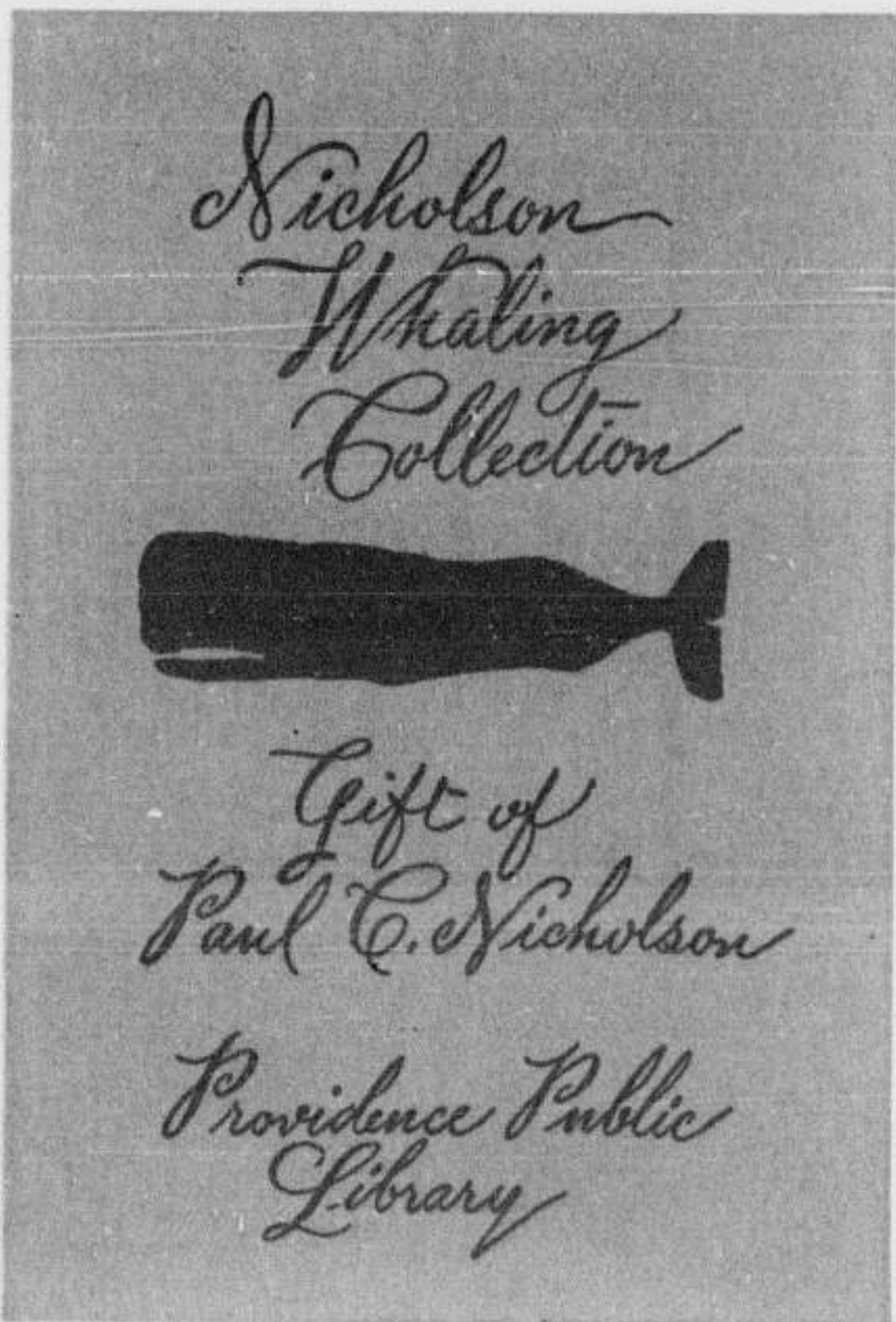

Saturday Jan 17<sup>th</sup> 1867

All this day a fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant was boarded by a boat from the shore the 2<sup>nd</sup> mate Shipkeeper and 2 Boatswains went ashore in the boat so ends this day

Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> 1867

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant all hands employed in clearing ice and setting sails took our anchors and dropped farther up into the harbor the 2<sup>nd</sup> mate Shipkeeper and 2 Boatswains ashore

Monday 21<sup>st</sup> 1867

Strong gale from the S.E. and rugged laying with both anchors ahead at 4 o'clock P.M. the gale broke and wind hauled to the N.W. during the gale the Schr E. M. Dyer dragged into the S.M. Collins and carried away her Bowsprit the 2<sup>nd</sup> mate Shipkeeper and 2 Boatswains ashore

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> 1867

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant at 10 o'clock P.M. the 2<sup>nd</sup> mate Shipkeeper and 2 Boatswains came aboard took our anchors and proceeded to sea at 2 o'clock passed Race point and steered N.W. by Compass all sail set at 8 o'clock P.M. lost sight of Chatham light bearing N.W. by S from which we take our departure
