latitude 38 27
long 72 27

Sunday 29
The day with light breeze from SE and at
daylight made all sails and at 11 am
saw 3 or 4 sperm whales and drove
the boat and E. B. got fast and got
one small whale and brought them
long suit and cutting them in
pieces cutting at 7 p m so end
latitude 38 27 long 72 40
