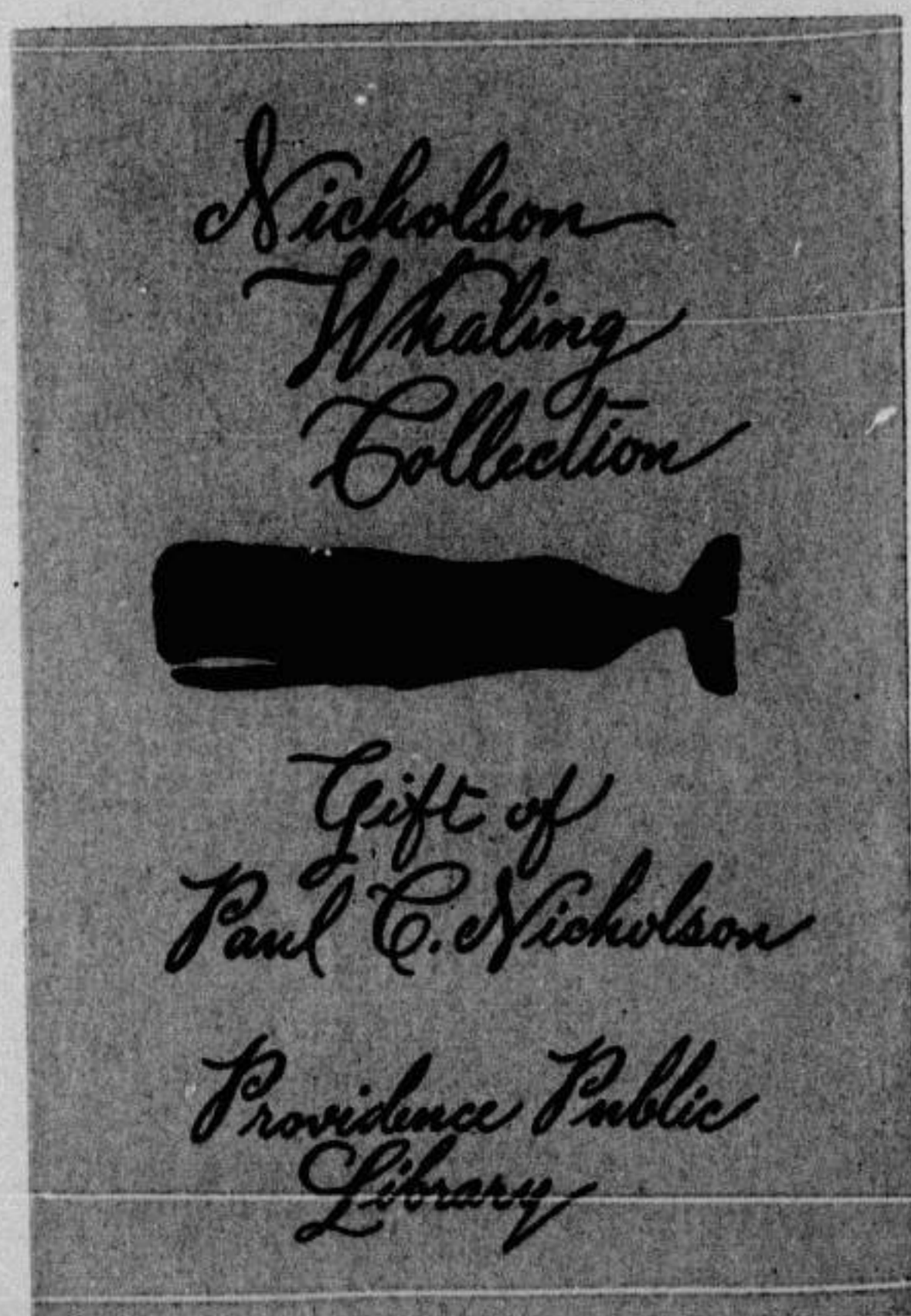


Capt Lincoln will find a Hll of
