Tuesday Nov 18 1851

This day begins with light breezes from the N.W. Steering S.E. by E watch employed in ship duty and fitting the boats Middle part light wind latter part fresh breeze watch employed in putting on chafing gear so ends this day. Loath Seony

Wednesday Nov 19

This day commences with strong winds from the N.E. by N ship steering S.W. by E all hands on deck employed in fitting the boats Middle part strong winds dull rapid the fore and mizen top sail latter part the wind cald made all sail broke out for water. so ends Loath Seony

Thursday Nov 20

This day commences with strong wind from N.E. Steering S.W. watch employed in broking out the run and fitting the boats Middle part the wind lured latter part strong breeze from the S.W. course S.E. & watch employed in stowing away potter so ends Loath Seony

Friday Nov 21

This day begins strong winds and increases to a gale ship ste laging to under close reefed main top sail fore sail fore topmast stay sail and main spencer at 7 o'clock in the evening stob in the fore sail the wind blew again from the N.W. and had heavy squalls of rain latter part the wind lulled and made all sail de land Loath Seony

Saturday Nov 22 This day begins with light breeze from the N.W. steering S.E. by E watch employed in ship duty saw a school of porpoise under the boat so ends Loath Seony
