Condition when received: Small quarto volume. Leather spine and corners deteriorated. Marbled sides badly worn. Paper acid. Pages missing. Covers loose.

Work performed: Disassembled, cleaned pages, deacidified, mended and guarded as necessary and resewed on four tapes. Rebound in new boards, best calfskin spine and corners, and Japanese paper sides (Moriki) over which replaced original marbled paper. Charles Taber label salvaged from under pasted-down end sheets glued to inside front cover.
