

Monday 7<sup>th</sup> Strong winds from  
E. Standing to S. S. E. at 3 pm  
Winds shifted to S. S. E. then tacked  
Ship to E. N. E. at sunset blowing fresh  
& squally doubled reef to top sails  
thick & squally

Middle part blowing a smart gale  
tack in the fore & Mizzen top sail  
upwind S. S. E. heading  
Later part tack in the main top sail  
& forward set the main spinnaker  
blowing hard then tack in the  
main later tacked by the E. later  
to S. E. Lat 39.47 Long 66.66

Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> Moderate gales from  
N. E. last part top sails the mizzen  
hauler to S. S. W. heading S. E.  
at sunset wind from S. W. across  
S. E. thick weather  
Middle strong winds from  
W. S. W. & squally with a heavy  
swell from S.

Later part with the same  
course E. S. Lat 37.24 Long 62.66

Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> Strong winds from W. S. W.  
Course E. S. all sail out variously  
in play at sunset squally

Middle part winds from N. W. E.  
Later light rains from E. on the E. tack  
Lat 37.24 Long

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> Light breeze from E. Standing  
to N. W. E. thick & rainy in play  
later part the W. hake out & E.

Middle at 12 Light rains from S. E.  
Course E. all hands in play

Later part fine winds from S. W.  
Course E. all sail out  
Lat 38.03 Long 60.09

Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> Light breeze from S. W.  
quite clear Course E. all sail out  
in play in fitting ship 1 sail of  
the lee beam

Middle strong winds from S.  
& squalls of rain doubled reef  
to top sails  
Later part strong winds from  
S. W. & squally Lat. Long 56.54
