Home in April 6. 1857

Wednesday 11. Wind N E and strong
happening winds ship drop up on wind
at 4 P M from Madaket clearing out
to the N of the gulf at 3 P M the water
quite green employed in heaving over
board timbers etc all overboard
at 6 Saunders the bottom
Light house from N W E ship heading to
N W

Middle Calms

Later Light house from N W
on track variously employed
General haul in site

Lat 37 00 Long 73 15

Thursday 12

Light house from N W ship
on track at 4 P M wind shifted
to N W E strong winds and thick
weather at 6 P M double reef
top sails still under heads N W E
ship on track

Middle and later Mouth
the same

Friday 13 Strong winds from
N E on track at 4 P M tacked ship
to E

Middle tacked ship to N W
the weather thick and cold
