When I arrived at the S. Islands on the 21st I found my Chanaan to be 38 miles to the Eastward had a standing rate since leaving Salentman when rate was 40,00 +

Now it is the same to make his rate I let him go on a standing rate from that day
Apr 21. Standing Rate 40,00

Remarks April 20th the day made out landed on the side of Salentman ship in some open space then made sail for when arrived there with 21. Ship of course on the 21st day the Squad my vessel got the side of Salentman arrived there on the 22nd. Sun was clear but little fresh it being very high at 4 PM left the side then Squad my vessel for the North by stretch beam

Remarks see below Saturday 23rd Ship N.E. trade Course W.W.W. all sail out to left the side on the 24th of course to

Ship Liverpool Bound North ^{27/53}

This Day Strong breeze from West to rounded to North West and hoisted with light rain in the forenoon in repairing main top sail at 4 PM finished and bent it at sunset made out with a heavy swell from the West

Lat 29.30 Long 170.00

Remarks On board Sunday 30th 53 have had strong winds from the West the last 2 days and a very heavy swell from the West the ship has been driven from W.W.W. ship stop square on a tack the weather very thick and heavy but times don't get a long way past now very

but still in hope I shall get up in season to get 2000 Bbls this season if I can get that much but have a thousand more

My Log is about 30.10 and Long 173.30

Remarks Sunday May 1st 1853 This Day Strong breeze from W.W.W. ship on a tack ship up again I want get to the North land but still in hope to get a slant soon and pay off all this at 6 PM tacked the ship to West bound - hoisted sails
