

At Pond Lake, Journal of A Whaling Voyage
July 15, 1844. Monday At 5 AM we got underway Wind
S.W. and Light. Stead out to Sea at 11 AM the pilot left
Light hoisted from the Masthead Had the Chances below
Secured the anchors on the bow

Tuesday July the 16. Begins with Light hoist from the
chase watches and began to get for Whaling made
Light hoist from N.W. Later Strong hoist from E. with
thick fog weather

Friday July the 19. Begins with Light hoist from N.W.

N.W. with fine weather made and Later fine
hoist from N.W. employed in fitting Whaling Apparatus

Lat 39° 34' Long 61° 16' W

Saturday July 20. Begins with fine weather Wind S.W.
Chase hoist hoist. Made and Later fine hoist from N.W.

Lat 40° 05' Long 57° 50' W

Sunday July 21. Begins with moderate hoist from West
with Light hoist of same kind and Later fine hoist

Lat 40° 21' Long 57° 50' W

Monday July 22. Begins with fine weather Wind
S.W. Made and Later fine hoist from N.W.
Saw a Blackbird Got fast and away
