

Remarks. On Board of the Brig E. H. Adams  
August 1870.

Friday 26<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine weather and light breeze  
from the N. the Brig heading W. by S.  
Saw one sail and caught one dolphin  
Scatter part - 1  
took a breeze from the  
SW. the Brig steering SW. this 24 hours. Lat. 37. 34.

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with hazy weather  
and a strong breeze from the SW.  
the Brig by the wind heading SW.  
at 2 P.M. parted the barboard. Flying jib  
took on the flying jib topmast staysail  
and main sail and kept the fore topmast  
set out a new gic one sail to the S of us  
Scatter part.

at 12 P.M. took the wind  
from the N. the Brig steering SW. by W.  
this 24 hours. Lat. 38. 04. S  
Long. 63. 22. W.

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with clear weather  
and a strong breeze from the S. E. the Brig steering  
S. W. by W. at 6 P.M. set the main sail & flying jib  
Scatter part. Light changeable air  
the Brig by the wind heading SW so ends this 24 hours.  
Lat. 39.  
Long. 64. 58 W.

Homeward Bound from a whaling voyage

August 1870.

Monday 29<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine weather  
and light changeable air the Brig heading SW  
at 6 P.M. took to the N. the wind from  
the SW.

Scatter part  
the Brig heading cloudy & changeable.  
S. by W. till 10 the puff.  
employed in painting some 20 ends this 24 hours  
Saw porpoises. Lat 39. 05. N

Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with cloudy weather  
and a moderate breeze from the W. S. W.  
the Brig heading S. by W. at 2 P.M. took the wind  
from the SW. the Brig heading S. W. by W.  
Scatter part.

Lazy weather saw a number of  
Birds & some sea weed & some fin back.  
this 24 hours. employed in cleaning  
the rig works. So ends this 24 hours. Lat. 40. 58. S  
Long. 66. 51 W

Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup>

Commenced with hazy weather  
and a moderate breeze from the SW.  
the Brig by the wind heading N. W. by W.  
Scatter part. Light air from the SW. the Brig heading  
W. saw a flat of fishermen so ends this 24 hours.  
got soundings at 2 o'clock on Georges Bank 23 fathoms  
at 6 o'clock 33 fathoms Lat. 40. 26. S. Long. 67. 17 W.
