

Remarks On Board of The Bark Sea Fox.
Captain William W. Eldred. Sailed April 18th 1871
For the Atlantic Ocean. for a Whaling Voyage
April 1871.

Tuesday 18.

This day ends with fine weather
& a light breeze from the SW at 11. Still took
our Anchors. & departure from New Bedford.
With a Pilot on Board. So ends this 24 hours.
Lat. Long.

Wednesday 19.

Commenced with fine weather & strong
breeze from the SW. the Ship working out of
Burrards Bay, at 4 PM stowed one of our cables
at 11. PM set the Pilot on Board of the Hens & the
light Ship. & proceeded on our voyage steering S.
Scatter Part

Spoke Bark Gillin Snow. Bound
to New Bedford. 42 months out. Campbell master
this will fill our Boats. So ends this 24 hours.

Thursday 20.

Commenced with hazy weather
& a moderate breeze from the SE. the Bark By the
wind heading E.
Scatter part.

Squally & changeable & the Bird
S. at 12. at 11. to the S. two Steamers to the S. & W.
So ends this 24 hours Lat by 2 PM 40. 12 & Long 69. 43. W.

Friday 21

Commenced with squally weather & a strong
breeze from the S. the Ship under double reef & fore
course steering E. this PM steering SE. Passed Pilot Boat #13.

at 6 PM closed reef & took on the main
course. the Ship steering SE by S.
Scatter Part

thick hazy weather saw Porpoises
& Gulf weed the Bark. C heading SE by S.

Saturday 22.

Commenced with thick hazy weather
& a light breeze from the NW the Bark steering
SE. by SE. Scatter Part

thick hazy weather
& light wind. So ends this 24 hours L. 38. 20 & Long 72

Sunday 23.

Commenced with hazy weather
& calm. the Bark heading SW
Scatter Part

Clear. weather & a strong breeze
from the NW. the Bark steering SE by SE & SSE.
Saw Black fish & porpoises So ends this 24 hours
Lat 37. 29. W. Long 65. 36. W.

Monday 24.

Commenced with clear weather &
a strong breeze from the NW. the Bark steering
SE by S. under double reef topsails
Scatter part.

Cloudy. weather & a strong
breeze from the NW. at 8 PM a large ship passed.
Saw some fin backs. So ends this 24 hours L. 36. 26
L. 63. 01. W.
