Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences with squally weather  
& light changeable air. Bark heading to the N  
caught 1 dolphin & 4 leather jackets & saw porpoises  
Better part fine weather and light breeze  
Bark steering to the N.E. So ends this 24 hours. Lat. 31.03. S  
Long. 117. 51. 117.

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather  
and light breeze from the S.W. Bark steering N.E.  
at 2 P.M. saw a big yellow pine stick toward down  
and caught a mess of fish at 2 P.M. bayinjahack  
Better part some clouds and lightning  
Bark steering N.E. So ends this 24 hours.  
Lat. 31.34 Long. 117. 51

Friday 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather  
and light breeze from the S.W. bark steering  
N.E. at 2 P.M. heaved to the wind on the port tack  
heading N.W.  
Better part much the same  
So ends this 24 hours. Lat 31.45 Long 117. 06

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather  
and moderate breeze from the S.W.  
Better part much the same so ends this 24

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> Commences with fine weather  
and light breeze from the S.W.

Better part strong breeze so ends this 24 hours  
Bark heading N.W. Lat 32. 08. Long 117. 02
