Left Fairhaven Mar 14<sup>th</sup> 1858  
With Wind from N.W. wind shifted  
until get down of Chatham when it  
shifted to N at Land about 10 Miles  
of Steaming S.S.E

Mar 15<sup>th</sup>

We saw a Sabley breeze from N. Steaming  
out S.S.E in company with Little  
C. Cook Capt. Squire Sykes  
Lat 40. 18 Lon 68. 16

Sat

Mar 16<sup>th</sup>

Still cruising with wind from  
N Sykes in company now after vessels  
one large Sabley Sloop bound to East  
Came up with Sabley Sloop at 2 o'clock  
Separated from Capt Sykes about 2  
o'clock by S Wind going down wind  
Lat 40. 00 Lon 67. 45

Sun

Mar 17<sup>th</sup>

Took mammal at day light saw the  
Whaling Sch M. E. Simmons Capt Reich  
with 2100 breeze from S at 12 o'clock  
took in Mammal and set Trawl  
at 4 o'clock P.M. took also Trawl  
in Trawl blowing and sailing  
Lat 36. Lon 66. 55
