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Towards Western Islands. 1849

Saturday June 16. 1849.

At 9 o'clock took over. Anchor and stood
Out of the Bay winds S.W. at Ends there 24 hours.

Sunday June 17.

Came with fine breeze from S.W.
Working out the Bay weather good at 11 P.M. Discharge
S.E. wind light from weather Lane in sight. Tattered
Part good weather Steering S.E. & S.E. under all sail saw
one ship to Eward there 24 hours Lat by Obs 40.18 Long 69.30

Monday June 18.

Came with fine breeze from North
Steering S.E. under all sail. Middle & latter part
Light winds in calms all hands employed fitting boats
to Eward there 24 hours Lat Obs. 39.14 Long by Obs 69.30

Tuesday June 19.

Came with fine breeze from S.W. Steering
S.E. under all sail. Middle & latter part good weather
Steering S.E. all hands employed in ship duty Success
Bank & Brig to Eward there 24 hours Lat Obs. 38.50 Long Obs 69.30

Wednesday June 20.

Came with fine breeze from S.W.
Steering S.E. under all sail saw 2 sails steering E.W.
Middle part good weather latter part fine breeze from
Westward Steering E.W. under all sail at Ends there 24 hours
Lat Obs. 37.37 Long Obs 69.30

Thursday June 21.

Came with fine weather Steering E.W.
under all sail then that a Middle part in calms latter
part light winds & calms Steering East saw one ship
Steering East to Eward there 24 hours
Lat 37.48 Long Obs 69.30
