Remarks on Friday Oct 25th

Since 24 hours strong breezes from SE and cloudy weather... at 10 AM took in main 3 fallant sail & set main sail...

Remarks on Saturday Oct 26th

Throughout these 24 hours strong breezes from SE and cloudy... at 7 AM took in top sails and set main 3 fallant sail...

Remarks on Sunday Oct 27th

Very strong breezes from SE & cloudy weather... at 11 AM took in job and main sail set main 3 fallant sail...

Remarks on Monday Oct 28th

First and middle part strong gales from South and heavy rain... at 5 AM took in top sails & fore sail heading SE...

Remarks on Tuesday Oct 29th

First part fresh breezes from North and cloudy weather... at 5 AM took in top sails & fore sail heading SE...

Remarks on Wednesday Oct 30th

Since 24 hours fresh gales from N and cloudy weather... at 5 AM took in top sails & fore sail heading SE...

Remarks on Thursday Oct 31th

These 24 hours fresh gales from North and clear weather... at 4 PM set double reef top sails and fore sail...

Passage out through the Atlantic Ocean A.D. 1850

Remarks on Friday Nov 1st

All this day strong variable winds from North... at 11 AM took in top fallant sail set at 11 AM...

Remarks on Saturday Nov 2nd

Throughout these 24 hours fresh breezes from East... at 5 PM took in top fallant sails...

Remarks on Sunday Nov 3rd

These 24 hours strong breezes from East to SE... at 10 AM took in top 3 fallant sail...

Remarks on Monday Nov 4th

Throughout these 24 hours strong gales from SE... at 5 PM double reefed top sail at 8 AM...

Remarks on Tuesday Nov 5th

These 24 hours heavy gales from Southward... at 5 AM closed reefed main top sail...

Remarks on Wednesday Nov 6th

First part heavy gales from SE and thick rain... at 5 AM took in top sail and spinnaker...

Remarks on Thursday Nov 7th

Very little heavy gales from N and rainy... at 5 AM took in fore 3 sail and fore sail...

Remarks on Friday Nov 8th

Very little heavy gales from North and squally... at 2 PM set main top sail closed reefed...
