Th April 25<sup>th</sup> 1878  
9 o'clock Am voyaged our anchor & put  
to sea with wind S. S. W 2 o'clock  
1 Pm took our Departure from Highland  
Light Steering E. by N So Ends

Th April 26<sup>th</sup> 1878  
This 24 hours Light air from N. S. W.  
It thick fog Steering full E by making  
2 E. by N. S. East part of Longitude  
So Ends

Th April 27<sup>th</sup> 1878  
This 24 hours fresh breeze from S by E  
3 It thick fog 4 o'clock Am tacked ship  
wind started to E heading to S.  
So Ends

Th April 28<sup>th</sup> 1878  
4 This 24 hours fresh breeze from E. S. E  
middle of East part wind backing with  
rain barometer falling weather looking bad  
Ball 38-39 Long 65-17
