Mon April 29<sup>th</sup> 1878

5 First part of this 24 hour brisk breeze from S. S. E. & Squally took in mainsail & fore sail Middle & Fore part Calm So Ends Lat 39.25 Long 65.15

Tu April 30<sup>th</sup> 1878

6 This 24 hour commenced with Breeze. Breeze from S. S. E. & Squally & took had a heavy Squall from N.W. took in all sail Daylight saw school of sperm whales going quick to N. appear we got ready then turned to westward Did not lower the air in cite most all day So Ends Lat 39.04 Long 64.47

Wed May 1<sup>st</sup> 1878

7 First part of this 24 hour Brisk Breeze from S. S. E. Middle & Fore part Calm & Squally So Ends

Th May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1878

8 First part of this 24 hour Light air from N.W. Middle & Fore part Brisk Breeze Steady S by E So Ends Lat 37.39 Long 61.21

Fri May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1878

9 First part of this 24 hour Brisk Breeze from N.W. Fore part Calm So Ends Lat 35.43 Long 61.01



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Sa May 4<sup>th</sup> 1878

10 This 24 hour Light air from S. S. Calm Riv one sail & plinback hoisted Reck to practice crew So Ends Lat 33.42 Long 60.35

Su May 5<sup>th</sup> 1878

11 First part of this 24 hour Calm Middle & Fore part Breeze from S. S. E. So Ends Lat 35.56 Long 60.38

Mon May 6<sup>th</sup> 1878

12 This 24 hour Brisk Breeze from S. S. E. Fore part took in mainsail fly get air to sail So Ends Lat 35.58 Long 60.50

Tu May 7<sup>th</sup> 1878

13 First part of this 24 hour Brisk Breeze from S. S. E. Middle & Fore part Squally from S.W. So Ends Lat 35.40 Long 58.10

Wed May 8<sup>th</sup> 1878

14 First Part of this 24 hour Brisk Breeze from W. Middle & Fore part fresh breeze & exchanged Longitude with a foreign Barge we were five degrees to westward of him So Ends Lat 34.21 Long 57.40

Th May 9<sup>th</sup> 1878

15 This 24 hour Brisk Breeze from S.W. & Squally Squally Long under to reef fore sail & haul So Ends Lat 32.50 Long 55.48
