On May 10th 1878

15 On 24 hour Brink Breeze from N. S. W. to hazy six phinback 4 see Log of birds took in Sail to S. So Ends Quarter watches to right Lat 31.45 Long 54.13

On May 11th 1878

16 On 24 hour Light Breeze from N. S. W. to East part the same six phinback to Ends Lat 30.23 Long 52.56

On May 12th 1878

17 On 24 hour Light air from W. S. W. pleasant Steaming to S. E. six phinback 4 one Log of birds of Squire Sundown here to to S. W. to Ends Lat 29.39 Long 52.13

On May 13th 1878

18 First 4. Middle part Light air from S. W. East part Calm six Blackfish Going quick to W. So Ends Lat 29.52 Long 51.30

On May 14th 1878

19 First part of three 24 hour Light air from S. W. Middle 4 East part Brink Breeze from S. S. W. six Log 4 4 whittaker Sundown took in Sail to S. E. So Ends Lat 30.23 Long 50.18

On the Western Ground 1878

Wed May 13th 1878

20 First part of three 24 hour Brink Breeze from S. S. W. thick 4 raining daylight had Squal from S. W. took in Sail 4 4 o'clock inside Sail 4 seen dried away Calm weather very thick 4 hazy. An 1/2 p.m. saw Seal Spinn Whaler might head East to Lower Boat between the boat 4 went down there away. thick 4 raining all day some times good breeze 4 some times calm while the Boat was out the sea Blackfish So Ends weather thick Lat 30.15 Long 50.00



On May 16th 1878

21 First part of three 24 hour Brink Breeze from S. Middle part wind from S. S. E. exchanged Longitude with being his way 50.44 to 50.24 in Lots of Drift stuff in sheets this forenoon see nothing more 3 o'clock in phinback 4 4 o'clock saw Seal Spinn whaler going quick to E. by N. Lower boat but whaler got head of wind weather was so thick 4 hazy couldnt see nothing or so nothing whaler going to W. East we see of them So Ends Lat 30.12 Long 50.25
