On May 17th 1878

First part of this 24 hours brisk breeze from S & W middle & last part wind W 12 Clock rose drift stuff 1 Clock rose skinback 3 Clock rose Thud Thud whaler going quick to N. & W. Leased boats got one whale Blackfish & hairpins making them go 6 Clock Every thing made snug for the night So Ends Lat 30.15 Long 50.00

On May 18th 1878

23

More 24 hours brisk breeze from W Daylight commenced cutting to right were ship to NW & last to leeward all Day getting in the whale So Ends Lat Long

On May 19th 1878

24

More 24 hours brisk breeze from N. & W with a heavy swell from NW commenced trying to leeward AM So Ends Lat 30.17 Long 49.19

On May 20th 1878

25

More 24 hours brisk breeze from N. & W with a heavy swell from NW at noon cooled down oil so hot did not finish Steaming down So Ends Lat 30.25 Long 49.10

On May 21th 1878

First part of this 24 hours Squally & rainy mid & last part more pleasant six one Sail to leeward of tide ribs Stowed down 30 lbs So Ends Lat 30.28 Long 49.26

Wed May 22th 1878

27

More 24 hours Light air from W. N. W & Squally Leased boats for practice in hairpins Ground & skinback So Ends Lat 30.25 Long 49.42

On May 23th 1878

28

More 24 hours Light air & calm Went out our new Forgal & bent our old one Leased boat for practice So Ends Lat 30.22 Long 49.55

On May 24th 1878

29

More 24 hours Light air from S & calm six Grampus & skinback So Ends Lat 30.22 Long 50.32

On May 25th 1878

30

More 24 hours Light air from N. & W Squally & calm Sun down heavy swell from W took in every thing but Oil & Forgal So Ends Lat 30.18 Long 50.24
