close tow watch employed general work.

Saturday April 15

Light wind from W schooner under all  
sail steering North by compass  
employed general work  
nothing today.

Sunday April 16

Strong wind from W schooner under  
all sail steering North by compass.  
at 10 a.m. wind hold from E strong  
with rain squalls vessel rolling very  
so the end today.
