Left the Wharf at 9 am in tow of tug Boat Mellie With the Wind SW Got Down to NW of Pine and boayed away jibb Boom But Back to Clark Point to Repair

Friday Oct 27

Fresh Breeze from the NW Ship Still at anchor Employed in getting the Boats Ready for Whaling

Saturday Oct 28

Fresh Breeze from the SW at 1 o'clock the Biggers Come on Board With a new jibb Boom and Rigged it sent it Out got under Way at Four o'clock in tow of tug Boat Mellie the Tug left at 7 o'clock and the Valt Ship Stearing S.E. middle Part Rain East Part got the Anchor on the Bows and Put the Chains below And Washed Ship
