Extract from log book - Ship CADMUS of Fairhaven:

September 1, 1836. At 5 P. M. we kept off and spoke the ship GEORGE CLINTON of Hudson, Capt. Barrot, gaming with the WILLIAM WIRT of Fairhaven, Capt. Dagit. Capt. Crowell went on board of her.

Extract from log book - Ship "Richard Mitchell" of Nantucket  
June 2 1837 - "hailed the ship "George Clinton" of Hudson - Capt. Samuel Barrot 34 mo. 1300 lbs. - see entry this log June 2 1837

Extract from log book - ship "Dartmouth" of N.B.

Jan. 19 1837 - "spoke the ship Mount Vernon and Governor Clinton of Hudson 30 months out 1300 lbs game 5 with her - "French Rock in sight"

and this log says Jan 18th

Monday commenced with strong breeze from  
W. cloudy weather starting at 10 AM  
at three ships in sight at 1 PM  
cloudy & B.S. middle and latter part strong  
breeze from W. all still sit at  
1 PM took in the top gable  
sails and double reefed the top  
sails latter part thick weather  
later 40-41  
long 40-48

Tuesday commenced with strong  
breeze from W. at 6 PM hauled to N. & W.  
cloudy weather middle and latter  
part continued strong breeze with  
signals of rain course B.S.  
later by the 20-13

Wednesday commenced with slight breeze  
from West cloudy weather middle  
and latter part light breeze  
at 11 AM spoke a schooner from  
Stamington bound to the Pacific  
later by the 40-28

Thursday commenced with light breeze  
from S.W. starting by 10 to the N.E.  
at 10 PM hauled to S middle and  
latter part light breeze from  
the south with clear weather  
later by the 40-13  
long in 6-28
