Wednesday 11th This day strong winds and fine weather nothing in sight so ends this day.

Thursday 12th These twenty four hours light winds and pleasant weather steering for Charles Island nothing in sight.

Friday 13th These twenty four hours light wind and good weather at 7 A.M. see the land at half past 4 came to anchor at Charles Island nothing more remarkable.

Saturday 14th This day light winds and good weather lying at anchor at Charles Is.

Sunday 15th These twenty four hours light winds and pleasant so ends this day.

Monday 16th This day light winds and good weather hands employed in painting ship so ends this day.

Tuesday 17th These twenty four hours light winds and good weather hands employed in painting ship so ends this day.

Wednesday 18th These twenty four hours good weather got off 16 lbs potatoes.

Thursday 19th This day light winds and good weather hands employed in getting off potatoes so ends this day.

Friday 20th This day light winds and good weather employed in getting off potatoes.

Saturday 21st This day light breeze and fine weather.

Sunday 22nd These twenty four hours light winds at 8 A.M. weighed anchor and stood out to sea nothing more remarkable so ends this.

Monday 23rd These twenty four hours fresh breeze steering S.W. by S. nothing more remarkable.

Tuesday 24th This day strong breeze and fine weather steering to the S. Westward Long 25°.

Wednesday 25th This day fresh winds and good weather steering S. by S. Lat 4° 35' S.

Thursday 26th This day light winds and good weather steering to the westward so ends.

Friday 27th This day strong winds and good weather steering to the S and Westward so ends.

Saturday 28th These twenty four hours strong winds and good weather latter part hauled up the courses fished the topgallant sails nothing in sight.

Sunday 29th These twenty four hours strong winds and good weather at 6 P.M. took in the topgallantails so ends.

Monday 30th First part of these twenty four hours light winds and good weather Middle and latter part the same latter part double reefed the topsails so ends.

Tuesday 1st This day strong winds and good weather nothing in sight so ends.

Wednesday June 1st 1836 This day strong winds and good weather at 12 past 10 spoke the ship Marcus
