These 24 hours very light winds  
from the S and S.E. steering by  
the wind. This day good weather  
Lat 37° 00' S.

Sept 8<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day light  
winds and fine weather steering  
S. winds from the S. E.  
at midnight wind backed  
to the S.W. and east steering  
by the wind with the starboard  
ward tacks on board so ends  
Lat 37° 37' S.

Sept 9<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours light winds  
and fine weather at 9 A.M.  
took a lunar observation  
Long 72° 48' W. Lat 39° 40' S.

Sept 10<sup>th</sup>

This day light winds from  
the S.E. steering S.E. by S.  
several ships in sight at  
10 A.M. took a lunar of  
observation so ends  
Long 72° 37' W. Lat 40° 13' S.

Sept 11<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day  
light winds and fine weather  
middle part the same latter  
part foggy with rain lying  
with main yard a back off  
Black Island so ends this day  
two barks in sight
