

Thurs 16th of June clear weather light breeze from
the S.E. steering S.W. by E. the watch
employed scraping the brasses and
varnished it and painted the ship
out side the Galen on the S. bow
Lat 51° 31' 28" Long by thro 162 14 W

Fri 17th fine weather light winds from the
S steering S.W. by E at 3 m. sun
whales were seen 3 boats got nothing
one of the Galen's boats struck and ran
at 6 came on board and kept her off again
the Galen in company sprit abt 1/2 beam
Lat 52° 42' 28" Long by thro 68 27 W

Sat 18th Fine weather strong breeze from
the Southward steering S.W. by E
at 4 past 6 on hoar the try works
overboard the Galen ahead
steering the same course
Lat by thro 54 22 28 Long by thro 69 40

Sund 19th fine weather strong gales from the
S at daylight the Galen one point
off the lee bow at 10 m. double reef
the topsails the Galen off the lee
beam reef at the same time
at sun down the Galen into stern
about 1/2 m. dist the course S.W. by W
Lat 56 42 28 Long by thro 111 50 W
