

Tuesday Sept 16th 1893

Comes with a light breeze from NW and thick weather. Mid. and latter parts light breeze and calm with fine weather - working to W by the wind. Lat 46-53-N Long 53-58

Wednesday Sept 17th

Comes with a light breeze from NW and fine weather. Mid. and latter part fresh breeze at S.W. and good weather. Ship working to Westward by the wind.

Lat 44-56-N Long 55-05 W

Thursday Sept 18th

Comes with a strong wind from N.W.W. with squalls. Middle part moderate and pleasant from the same quarter. Latter part calm and pleasant. Skilled 3 casks with salt water stowed aft to trim ship.

Lat. 44-14-N Long 57-22 W

Friday Sept 19th

Comes with light air from S.W. and fine weather - heading to the N.W. under all sail. Mid part light breeze from S. - steering NW by N. 6 P.M. sighted Sable Island bearing N 11 W 15 miles distant. Wind weather the same. Lat 43-56-N Long 59-44 W

Saturday Sept 20th

Comes with a fresh gale from E - with good weather - 4 A.M. gale increasing furled the light sails and mainsail. 7 A.M. wind hauled to S.W. - hoisted to under close reefed fore and single reefed mainmast and staysails heading to N.W. Latter part heavy gale from W. - wore ship to S.W.

Lat 43-38 - Long 62-33 W

Sunday Sept 21st

First strong gale from W.N.W. with rain squalls - ship wore to under the same sail - at daylight set the courses and job - 4 P.M. wore ship heading N by E by compass. The gale continues strong from the same quarter - Lat 42-34 N Long 62-56 W

Monday Sept 22nd

Comes with a light breeze from N - steering W. under all sail. Mid and latter parts moderate wind from E - and fine weather. Saw a steamer steering to W. - drying boat sails and job on the rigging.

Lat 42-21 N Long 63-40 W

Tuesday Sept 23rd

Comes with light breeze from E. fine weather steering W. Mid and latter part light breeze var. from E to S.E. Several sails and foremast in sight.

Lat 42-16 N Long 66-31 W
