Dec 16 1852 on moved ship and
collected up in hour way for say
came too with last but unless above
ship

the 14 got on the way and hauled
in the channel came to anchor and
cleared ship and rain

the 18 sent out the flying jib boom
and fast the sail all hands on
board set up gear cleared ship

the 19 Clear warden unmoved ship
and toward dawn the harbor came
to anchor wind light at 5 a.m.
the pilot came on board and
on the way made all sail got
out to say full top gallant
sails and jib heading 7 e the
capt on shore wind e night
fine and set the Wash

the 20 wind 5 standing on and
off the harbor it hauled the
catt on spare hands in plyed
clearing ship at 10 a.m. flyed
ing hands close reefed the top
sails land bearing n e wind
and say in evening and rain
at 9 am bore to under a close
reef main top sail four top
mast stay sail and main
try sail flyed and raising

the 21
wind 5 blowing hard land bearing
ring n e heading 7 to W or there
made sail for whaler 3 miles
on under bore going to W
at 4 a.m. W or there land
bearing n e distant 10
Close reefed the top
sail blowing hard
5 heading 7
