a gout the rising at 9 a m dimont reefed  
the top sail standing in shore

saturday the 25 stormy wind W by N heading  
N W under reef top sail and four sail  
blowing hard says running high dimont head bear-  
ing W N W monapi bearing N E 2 ships in sight  
standing in shore hounds in playd working on board  
break out the main hawsers water and the old sail on back

coarse W S W Sunday the 26 fresh gales  
and rain getting up for the port of  
hanalda one ship in sight the same as  
we last the garrison rail over board lowered  
a boat and got at noon 1 dimont head  
bearing N W 20 miles  
pumped ship wind W S W  
heading N W by W in shore

moder wind S E light at 5 p m made sail  
heading in shore 2 sail in sight break out  
for water back out at the mast heads see  
fin backs set up the four top gallant back  
stays and four top gallant rising at 5  
a m took in sail heading S W by W

friday the 31 fine and rain got out a boat  
on the chis and got a old boat on the  
shady open head made sail heading in shore  
wind light W S W at 2 a m won ship he-  
ading W S W wind W N W at 6 a m took  
sail fresh gales and rain set  
wagh night dark and rain
