

Remarks On Board Ship Goethe April 24th 1856

At 4 AM ship lying at anchor in the Roads off Bremen Haven with the wind from East and pleasant - and the Pilot and all being on board took the anchor at 5 AM and steered ship down the Channel of the Weser for sea at 10 AM being out clear the Shoals of Boops discharged Pilot steered ship to NW latter part the same steering ship NW under all sail

Remarks On Board Friday Sea account April 25th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from ENE with fine weather steering ship NW, at 7 PM steered NW by N middle part light air from NE with pleasant weather steering ship NW, at 4 AM steered West by N latter part light air with fine weather steering ship Westward all sail several ships in sight
