Thursday Dec<sup>9</sup> at 11.30 let go from the  
wharf and was taking in ~~to~~ at 1.30 p. M  
tug left Schr under all sail heading  
S S W with light breeze from the S E and  
veering to the S at 7 P. M Schr heading S W  
under all sail middle and latter part strong  
breezes from the N W Schr steering S W by S  
at 2 A No took in sail So ends

New Bedford Dec<sup>10</sup> 1875 #10

Saturday Dec<sup>11</sup> Comes with  
strong breezes from the N W Schr heading  
S S W under short sail no observation  
at 7 P. M coast a ship heading to the N  
middle and latter part lite breezes from  
the N W steering S S W at 7 A No maid  
sail several sails in sight watch employ  
ed in ships duty at 11 A No wind hald S W  
So ends

Lat 37.15 N Lon 72.25 W

Sunday Dec<sup>12</sup> Comes with lite  
breezes from the S W Schr heading S by E  
under all sail watch employ in ships duty  
middle part lite veering winds from the west  
ward at 1 A No hauld to the N and breeze  
on latter part much the same Schr steering  
S by W several sails in sight So ends

Monday Dec<sup>13</sup> Comes with strong  
winds from the North steering S by W  
at 4 P. M reefed the fore sail at 6 P. M running  
under short sail middle part heavy weather  
from the westward lying to on the Starboard  
tack latter part heavy weather and clear lying to  
two reefs fore sail seen one sail So ends
