Remarks on board Thursday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> 1850  
Rigged anchor at 11 P.M. and  
got under way at 12 breeze did  
away and let go the anchor about 2  
P.M. & breeze sprung up and got under  
way again at 7 P.M. left Peterborough  
about 7<sup>1/2</sup> coast the watches  
and the harbor watch went below.

Remarks on board Friday Aug 16<sup>th</sup>  
moderate breeze from the S.W.  
and heading S.E. by E. employed  
in fitting the boats & sails in sight

Remarks on board Saturday Aug 17<sup>th</sup>  
strong breeze from the Eastward  
steering S.E. by E. saw a school  
of blackfish & four sails employed  
in fitting the boats

Remarks on board Sunday Aug 18<sup>th</sup>  
strong breeze from the  
westward steering eastward  
saw nothing so ends the day

Remarks on board Monday Aug 19<sup>th</sup>  
bore part strong breeze from the  
west after part southerly with rain  
heading S.W. by W. saw a sail

Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 20<sup>th</sup>  
strong breeze from the Westward  
heading S.W. by W. saw blackfish  
broke out for bread so ends the day
