home. May 28 ^W Uncle Samuel has gone to work to day, Mary
& me went to the Office to saw, Mendias left & I
lost a quarter of a dollar, we went back but we
could not find it. Then I went to Mary & Dr. Dr. Gleaming
Spencer both come. After we went out on the sidewalk
they talked about a quarter of an hour. I suppose they
were talking about Mary but I do not know.
Mother & Aunt Lucy have washed to day &
I ironed and Aunt Lucy has been up town.
May 29 ^W This afternoon Mary & Eliza went to the
Parker House in a Cablet, to see a Dr Boardman
that is there. Mary and me went up town and
went to Mrs Newell when we come back we staid till
5 or 6 o'clock. Mother & Aunt Lucy were there, Aunt
Lucy has most made a rest to day. We went up
to Mrs Newell to night and she said she could
take me and would like to have me come next
Monday so I guess I shall go if nothing happens.
May 30 ^W It is a rainy day to day, Mary has gone
up to the Dr's again to day. Mother & Aunt
Lucy are making Grandm' they came to day.
Caroline came up here and spent the afternoon to day.
May 31 ^W This afternoon it thundered & lightened & I
heard very hard indeed. The lightning struck a
pole & broke it all to pieces down by Greenwell's
