July 2^d 1854
 at midnight took our anchor in western River
 & stood out sea & sent up a new chain led galled mast &
 got ready for going to sea & waiting for some of our
 men to come this day

1. Remarks on Monday July 3^d 1854
 There 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from NW &
 fine weather sailing off & on at western Harbour
 waiting for some of the men at 2 P.M. the George & Hubert
 went to sea at 6 P.M. we all got on board & stood to
 sea with 23 men on board all tides stowed anchors &
 hoisted up deck & raised the watch & set the watch at 8
 P.M. stowed lower Island box East by compass 5 miles
 distance at 9 P.M. stand N.E. side & latter part of
 the day fine breeze from NW & smoky weather at 7 A.M.
 stand N.E. watch Empty, a in stowing the anchors & chains
 below our lower coils at 9 stand N.E. the day ends the same
 left in 40y 39.35 N long in 7 Chronomet. 62.25 west

1. Remarks on Tuesday July 4th 1854
 There 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from NW & smoky
 weather sailing N.E. all hands Empty, a in ships duty broke out the
 run & stowed down the rig iron & stowed up the run & lashed up
 the spars on deck & washed off the deck & other various kinds of
 work saw several seals in sight in the gulf stream side & latter
 part of the day fine breeze from NW & smoky weather watch
 Empty, a in ships duty getting the boats ready for whaling
 the day ends the same smoky & some cloudy weather
 left in 40y 37.35 N long in 7 Chronomet. 62.25 west

2. Remarks on Wednesday July 5th 1854
 There 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from NW &
 smoky weather sailing N.E. watch Empty, a in ships
 duty at 7 P.M. stand N.E. out of the stream middle & latter part of
 the day fine breeze & smoky weather watch Empty, a in ships duty
 sent up the Regatta gear & other various kinds of work since the day
 left in 40y 37.12 N long in 7 Chronomet. 62.15 west
