 Sailed June 30th 1898

Thursday June 30th at 9 A.M. all hands or crew on board so she sailed from the wharf with a large number of people on board that went as far as the keel and chickens Light Ship the Tag Boat took the the ship as far as that at 12 noon tug left the ship

- July 1 Commence with light breeze from S.W. and foggy weather heading N.N.W. at 4 P.M. went on the other tack heading S.S.E. latter part Fresh breeze and pleasant weather steering S.E. by S.

- 6 First part this 24 hours light breeze and fine weather steering S.E. by E.
 latter part the same steering E.S.E. Lat. 35:00
