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Bark Greyhound sails from New Bedford  
Sept 17 for Whaling Targe Schooner Sandford  
master. with 16 men before the mast  
and 4 officers. and 3 boat steers  
Steward and cook and Boy.  
Sails down the Bay with fore wind  
clear of Normansland at 6 P.M.  
So ends this day. Try the ships pump  
pump 40 minutes before she sets  
Sept 18. Ship under all sails steering  
SE. light Breeze from W.S.W.  
Engaged in clearing up the deck.  
So ends this day. in lat 39:47 W.  
long by dead Re. - 69:50  
pump the ship 50 minutes in 24 hours  
Sept 19 This day commence with strong  
Breeze in morning and Rain storm  
moderating at 1:30 P.M. Engaged in  
set up fore galan Back stay and Raze  
Ship under short sail heading SSE.  
in forenoon. and E.N.E. in afternoon  
with big sea on in lat 38:20 W. long 69:38  
So ends this day.  
pump ship every 12 hours 45 minutes  
Sept 20 This day commence with strong  
Breeze in morning and Rain storm  
Ship laying too under main lower  
topsail at 2 P.M. moderating make  
sail steering SE 1/2 S. wind from NW  
in lat 37:40 W. long 66:20 W.  
So ends this day.  
pump ship every 8 hours 45 minutes  
Sept 21 This day commence with light Breeze  
in morning and Rain storm and  
Breeze up strong in afternoon Engage  
in getting Boat ready for Whaling  
Ship under all sails steering SE.  
wind from SW. in lat 38:22 W. long 65:38  
ends this day
