

Aug 24 Throughout this 24 hours: light Breeze and pleasant weather Bk. under all sails out steering by the wind men employed at various ship works latter part much as yesterday

Aug 25 Today comes with fresh Breeze wind and pleasant weather Bk. heading along by the wind under upper topsail men employed at ship duty saw nothing at all, latter same condition

Aug 26 This day begun with light Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. under all sails out steering by the wind raised school of sperm whales by Mr. Santos and lowered down the 4 boats SBX and SB. got fast, got on board at 8:30 fastening the whales and set the watches latter employed in cutting and clearing away the heads

Aug 27 These 24 hours light breezes and pleasant weather Bk. under all sails out working up to westward raised two young bull whales by Mr. Montano and lowered down the four boats NB. struck and whale took the line away SB. Bend. on is line to it. latter the iron broke off. come on board and made the fire also at 5:30 raised same whale to the windward did not bother anymore it was let anyway. latter much as first,

Aug 28 First part of this day commences with light Breeze wind and fine clear weather Bk. heading along by the wind with all sails set. employed in boiling latter part of the much as yesterday saw one steamer also got through boiling

Aug 29 This day comes with fresh Breeze wind with clear weather Bk. under all sails set. steering by the wind men employed in run down the oil and storing away the things latter part squally like with rain also one merchant ship come by and fired shot.

Aug 30 Today begun with freshy. Westly wind Bk. under all sails out steers N.W. watches employed at various ship duty. saw great quantities of porpoises and Grampuss latter wind dying out with swells saw Grampuss

Aug 31 The last of this month gone with very little breeze almost calm Bk. laying around without head wags latter struck up little more breeze from SE. Bk. heading along N. by N. with all sails out latter fresh and squally weather
