

Wednesday Feb 9<sup>th</sup> 1859.  
Came with light wind from the S.W. beating  
out the Bay saw a bark going in, at 7 P.M.  
the Island of Quinquina bore S by E by compass  
15 miles, shore water, and beds coral.

Middle and latter part light wind and calm  
true sail in sight. Lat 36° 14' S Long 73° 22' W

Thursday 10<sup>th</sup>  
Calm, boats crews fitting their boats at 4.  
took a light breeze from the Southwest steering  
N.W. Sunset the same the coast in sight  
all day. Middle and latter part smart breeze  
from the Southwest steering N.W. Employed  
clearing and ridding chains.

Friday 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 33° 59' S Long 73° 33' W

Came with smart breeze from the Southwest  
steering N.W. Moved down the harbor  
chain and part of the harbor from the  
same. Middle and latter part the same  
finished steering the harbor chain saw nothing  
but furbats. Lat 31° 09' S Long 74° 06' W

Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> Lat 28° 34' S Long 74° 26' W

Came with the same wind and weather  
steering N.W. Saw nothing but furbats  
Middle and latter part the same steering N.W.  
Saw nothing. Lat 26° 43' S Long 74° 39' W

Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 25° 41' S Long 74° 46' W

Came with moderate breeze from the S.W.  
and steady steering N.W. Saw nothing  
Middle and latter part the same steering  
N.W. Saw nothing. Lat 25° 41' S Long 74° 46' W

Monday 14<sup>th</sup> Lat 24° 54' S Long 74° 46' W  
Came with light wind from the S.W.  
steering N.W. Saw nothing. Middle and latter part  
light and variable wind and calm. Lat 24° 54' S Long 74° 46' W

Wednesday Feb 9<sup>th</sup> 1859.  
Came with very light wind from the S.W. and  
steering N.W. Saw nothing. Sunset the same  
Middle and latter part light and variable wind  
and calm. Saw nothing. Lat 24° 05' S

Thursday 10<sup>th</sup>  
Came with calm, at 3 P.M. took a light breeze  
from the S.W. steering N.W. Sunset the same.  
Middle and latter part the same steering N.W.  
Employed tanning down head stags. Lat 22° 57' S Long 75° 46' W

Friday 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 21° 28' S  
Came with light wind from the S.W. steering  
N.W. finished tanning down the head stags.  
Middle and latter part light trades steering  
N.W. after breakfast sent up the Mast and  
boom and set the foretopmast and lower studding  
sails. Saw nothing. Lat 21° 28' S

Saturday 12<sup>th</sup>  
Came with light trades and pleasant steering  
N.W. Saw nothing. Middle and latter part the  
same, steering the same. Lat 20° 05' S

Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 19° 20' W  
Came with light trades and clear steering  
N.W. Saw some grampuses and an otter  
furbats. Middle and latter part strong trades at 8 A.M.  
Spoke the ship Philippe Delanoy, Governor of fair  
haven 35 miles 1360 sp. at 41 parted company
