Saturday Sept. 21.

Tacked again wind N.W. ship heading S.W. by W. by the middle part the same at 5 hours at N.W. ship by the heading S.E. by E. at noon the same, Employed in Ship's duty. P. So Ends.

Sunday Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>

these 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes from the W. S.W. ship under all sail heading S.E. by E. by the wind at 2 hours

Lat. P. M. Point Fuascama in sight, dist 10. 12-34. W. 10. miles bearing E. by S. at 3 hours P. M. tacked off shore wind, S.W. ship by the heading S.W. by W. middle part the same at 3 hours at N. wind from W. ship by the heading S. by E. at noon the same. Employed in Ship's duty. P. So Ends.

Thursday Sept. 26<sup>th</sup>

these 24 hours comes in fine winds W. ship under all sail heading S. by the wind at 2 hours P. M. Land

Lat. in sight dist 25 miles bearing S.E. 1-05. W. at 7 hours P. M. tacked off shore ship Long. heading S. by E. by the wind, middle part the same, at 4 P. M. wind W. ship by the heading S. at 4 P. M. one sail in sight heading S. at noon strong breezes from W. S.W. ship by the wind heading S. E. Employed in Ship's duty. P. So Ends
