M. ship steering a course G. E. at 4. P. M. Employed in Helling up cables & at 7. P. M. Cast the anchor off Sequimtas in 54 fathoms. Watter vield out 31 fathoms of cable and furled the sails and set the anchor watch at 5 hours of M. wind G. W. at 7 of M. Bark Samuel Thomas to anchor, this of M. Employed in setting up rearing & to ends

Saturday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>

these 24 hours comes in fine, winds from the G. ship laying at anchor in Sequimtas at 1 hour P. M. took the anchor and stood in to the anchorage at 1 hour and 30 minnits cast the anchor in 4 fathoms of watter this P. M. Employed in getting the weed off. at daylight wind G. and foggy weather, this of M. Employed in Breacking out the fore hold, at noon got off one boat load of fruit to ends,

Sunday Sept 29<sup>th</sup>

these 24 hours comes in fine. wind from the G. ship laying at anchor in Sequimtas this P. M. Employed in getting the weed off. at 5 hours P. M. got all the weed on Board at 7.30 minnits set the anchor watch at daylight. wind from the W. and fine weather Employed in ship's duty & to ends,

Employed in stowing the anchor & middle part strong breezes from the G. ship by to heading W. latter part the same Bark Samuel Thomas in sight this of M. Employed in stowing down the cable and painting the waist Boat & to ends,
