June 24 Lat 31.30 Long 73.54 Wind S.W.
steering S by E finished steering down on
40 lbs gunned the whaling sch
Golden City so ends this day

June 25 Lat 31.45 Long 71.59 Wind S steering
E. S.E. made a cutting haul out of
Towline & strapped flabs
so ends this day

June 26 Lat 31.25 Long 63.04 steady S.W. Wind
course E sighted a Steamer
so ends this day

June 27 Lat 31.36 Long 67.34 Wind light & S.W.
steering E saw a squarier ~~to~~ through
so ends this day

June 28 Lat 32.06 Long 65.45 Light South
Wind course E.S.E. saw numerous
indications of whales - so ends this day

June 29 Lat 32.00 Long 64.50 Light S Wind
steering E raised the Island of Bermuda
this morning ~~was~~ N. so ends this day

June 30 Lat 31.12 N Long 64.24 W Strong breeze
aged by squalls from the S.E.
heading S by the wind sighted a
large Bark so ends this month & day

July 1st Lat 30.08 Long 64.52 Wind S.E. strong
squalls with rain squalls heading E.S.E.
broke out water so ends this day

" 2nd Lat 30.50 N Long 64.43 W Wind E.S.E.
heading E.N.E. Mate boatsteres raised a
large whale early in the morning lanced
about 4 o'clock second mate struck
but guns dropped out chased him
most nor west till three o'clock but
did not get fast so ends this day

" 3rd Lat 31.45 North Long 63.32 W Light S.E.
Wind so ends this day

" 4th Lat 32.43 N Long 62.14 W Light S Wind
course sighted a Brig here in sight
all day steering same course -
so ends this day

July 5th Lat 33.06 Long 61.02 Light S Wind
steering E saw several pieces of
drift wood so ends this day

July 6th Lat 34.00 Long 59.43 Light Wind
changing from E by N to S.E. headed
S.E. tacked ship head S. numerous
indications of whales so ends this day

July 7th Lat 34.05 Long 59.38 Calm nearly
all day Mate boatsteres raised a spout
at ten o'clock saw it only four times
second mate boatsteres raised a
whale at half past six lanced &
chased one rising but darkness -
interposed whale heading N.E.
so ends this day
