1858

Monday

Aug 23^d

At 1/2 past 10 took the Anchor into
Limyard Harbour and beat up the
Sound under single reefed topsails
& courses at half past five discharged
Pilot. wind N West employed
Hauling the Anchor & Sails.

Tuesday Aug 24th

A moderate breeze from the Westward
middle and latter part the same
employed fitting the Boat
Sails & Hauling Sails
Lat N. Long W.

Wednesday Aug 25th

Commenced with light breeze from
the westward steering N E by E
middle and latter part the same
so ended employed breaking out Sails.
Lat N 39.07 Long W 80.55

Thursday Aug 26th

Begins with a light air from the westward steering
N E by E middle part wind hauled to the N E by E then
Latter part wind hauled to the Southward
heading N by S tack employed putting anchoring gear
Sun 3 Sails Sails Lat N 38.07 Long W 66.50
