November the 3 Day These 24 hours Commences with
light winds from the north & the water a boiling oil
at 1 P.m. Sailed with Bilt. & at 7 P.m. took

from the N.W. & at 8 P.m. all hands called
to make out the gun hole for Stowing down
Bilt. And raining thick weather & at 10 o'clock
at 11 P.m. finished Stowing Down & St. in midian
Bilt. Sailed this day but Sails making
Sails South 37. 59. And in Longitude west 40. 52

November the 4 Day These 24 hours Commences with
Strong breeze & all hands employe in washing of
Sails & C. & made Sails & Stowing. S. N. F. C.
At 7 P.m. took in Sails & Set the water & Sailing
and middle part rain & at 8 P.m. made Sails
and at 8 P.m. saw a right whale & bore away
but did not get the whale and came a board
and all hands employe in making mizen
